Chaperone Agreement

We are excited to have your group visit Pima Air and Space Museum. During your visit, you will enjoy over 400 aircraft ranging from military to commercial use. As a chaperone at the Pima Air and Space Museum, you are responsible for monitoring student behavior while on museum property. The museum is 80 acres, and many of the buildings are not air controlled. **Please make sure you are monitoring your students for desert conditions including heat, dehydration, animals, and uneven grounds.** While we want you to enjoy your visit, please understand that your priority is ensuring the students in your group act safely and respectfully during their visit. Failure to do so will result in your group being asked to leave the museum, or not receiving free/discounted admission for future visits.

Chaperone Guidelines:

- Keep all students in your assigned group within your sight and hearing at **ALL times.**
- Avoid congregating with other chaperones or groups.
- Intervene if the student is being unsafe, causing damage to museum property, or disturbing other guests.
- Alert museum staff immediately if damage occurs.
- Monitor your group of students inside the Museum Store. Please understand we limit the number of students in the store to 10.
- Monitor your group of students inside the Flight Grill and be present at the food area when students are purchasing/selecting food.
- Monitor student behaviors in the restrooms and to and from the restrooms.
- Do not allow your students to run or yell in the hangars.
- Do not allow your students to climb on aircraft/exhibits.
- Do not allow your students to throw/drop items off of the 2nd-floor balconies.

I understand that failure to supervise my students will result in the school/organization losing access to the free/discounted youth program and or the school/organization being charged for our visit or damages to the museum.
